LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 335

Introduced by Hansen, 26.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to examine the most recent report published by the Presidential Commission on Election Administration (Commission), review the recommended election law changes, and compare them to current Nebraska law. The study shall include, but not be limited to, an examination of the following issues:

- (1) The recommendations made by the Commission;
- (2) The recommendations made by the Commission that are not currently enacted into Nebraska law;
- (3) The recommendations made by the Commission that are already completely or partially enacted into Nebraska law; and
- (4) Legislative action necessary to mirror those recommendations made by the Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED FOURTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION:

1. That the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
