Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB205 defines a meteorological evaluation tower (MET) and requires such towers at a height of at least fifty feet but no more than two hundred feet to be marked as provided in the bill. The bill has a time provision for owners of METs to comply with the marking and registration requirements for towers that are currently erected and for towers that are yet to be erected. LB205 also allows the Department of Aeronautics to adopt and promulgate rules and regulations for carrying out the purposes of the bill.
