**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

**LB235**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 235 would authorize a licensed individual under the Medicine and Surgery Practice Act or the Optometric Practice Act to interpret and review information obtained by a kiosk or other device. LB 235 also ensures that these devices, if used, have been approved by the FDA and are compliant with both the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and federal Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996. Practitioners overseeing these devices would be required to clearly label the devices with the providers name and state license number and the owner would need liability insurance that would adequately cover claims made by persons diagnosed and treated using the information generated by the one of these devices.
