Introducer's Statement of Intent

LB383

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 383 would allow for registered voters in the state of Nebraska, who have moved within the state but did not re-register by the deadline, to vote provisionally and re-register at their new polling location. Under current law, this practice is already available to those who move within a single county, but not to those voters who move to a different county in Nebraska.

This bill would change the statute to ensure all registered voters in Nebraska would have the same benefit, regardless of where they move.
