The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 433 creates an offense of false presentation if a person presents, displays, or furnishes expired, cancelled, fake, counterfeit, false, or misleading evidence of an automobile liability policy, evidence of insurance, or proof of financial responsibility to any peace officer, prosecuting attorney, or other official with the intent to impede a criminal investigation or to acquire a motor vehicle registration.

A person convicted of a violation is guiltiy of a Class 1 misdemeanor and may have his or her operator's license revoked for a year.
