## **Introducer's Statement of Intent**

### **LB705**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 705 is a "clean-up" bill for statutes governing cities of the first class. The bill would amend sections of statute in Chapter 16 to make a variety of technical changes, including:

- Changing and correcting terminology
- Changing subject-verb agreement
- Changing references to improvement districts
- Clarifying references to cities' extraterritorial zoning jurisdiction or city limits
- Clarifying references to legal newspapers
- Correcting references to city officials
- Correcting gender references
- Eliminating run-on sentences
- Harmonizing references to other statutory sections within Chapter 16
- Replacing or eliminating antiquated, obsolete, or unnecessary language
