The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 785 allows the Department of Motor Vehicles to assume responsibility for the delivery of all driver licensing services, including fee collection in addition to the collection services now provided by county treasurers.

The bill eliminates the requirement that driver licensing services be provided in all counties.

LB 785 also provides that in counties where the department delivers all aspects of driver licensing services, (applications process, examinations, collection of fees, and issuing of receipts) the county portion of the fee shall be credited to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. In return, the county will not be required to provide office space or staff for the fee collection.
