The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB929 is a technical bill introduced on behalf of the Carrier Enforcement Division of the Nebraska State Patrol to ensure Nebraska statutes are current with the Federal Motor Regulations. The purpose of the bill is to adopt and update references to certain federal provisions relating to low-speed vehicles, handicapped or disabled parking permits, the International Registration Plan, operators' licenses, persons handling source documents, hazardous materials, motor carrier regulations and their enforcement, and the unified carrier registration plan and agreement.
