The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 967 is a bill that would amend the funding, student enrollment options, and boundary issues of school districts within the Learning Community in Omaha.

The bill has three primary components, to eliminate the Learning Community's common levy, to get rid of "Open" enrollment and return to "Option" enrollment and allow for school districts within the Learning Community to negotiate district boundaries.
