

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 366A

Approved by the Governor May 27, 2015

Introduced by Pansing Brooks, 28.

A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 366, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, First Session, 2015.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$40,000 from the General Fund for FY2015-16 and (2) \$48,000 from the General Fund for FY2016-17 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 347, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 366, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, First Session, 2015.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.

Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$347,687 from the General Fund and \$390,776 from federal funds for FY2015-16 and (2) \$421,802 from the General Fund and \$464,124 from federal funds for FY2016-17 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 348, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 366, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, First Session, 2015.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.

Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$6,377 from the General Fund for FY2015-16 and (2) \$7,736 from the General Fund for FY2016-17 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 421, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 366, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, First Session, 2015.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.

Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$11,160 from the General Fund for FY2015-16 and (2) \$13,538 from the General Fund for FY2016-17 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 424, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 366, One Hundred Fourth Legislature, First Session, 2015.

No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this section.
