* Under the **Length of Time** category, the number of hours includes time when the youth is in confinement status (not participating in normal activities with their assigned living unit, for safety or behavioral concerns). During this time, youth have the opportunity to be seen by medical status and their mental health therapist. They have recreation/exercise opportunities, are permitted to shower, have visitation with their family, phone calls and visits from their attorney. Based on their behavior, youth may have additional incentives given including visits from other youth in the facility.
