- LB 379 (*Harr*) Create the Willa Cather Historical Building Cash Fund and provide for a transfer of funds

- LB 697 (*Ebke*) Change certain district court judicial district boundaries
- LB 724 (*Wayne*) Provide for segregation of keno funds, electronic fund transfers, and deposit of gross proceeds by a sales outlet location as prescribed
- LB 714 (*Howard*) Provide a procedure for judicial emancipation of a minor
- LB 702 (*Kolterman*) Change provisions relating to children's health care coverage and Nebraska IV-D child support program modification procedures

GENERAL FILE: 2018 COMMITTEE PRIORITY BILLS - "*Watermeier Division*"

- LB 1081 (*Education Committee*) Change education provisions regarding reporting, penalties, residency, boundaries, priority schools, subpoena authority, poverty, and limited English proficiency
- LB 861 (*Watermeier*) Require that certain prosecution costs be paid by the state

GENERAL FILE: 2018 SENATOR PRIORITY BILLS - "*Hilkemann Division*"

- LR 269CA (*Schumacher*) Constitutional amendment to authorize the Legislature to delegate complete or partial sovereignty to one area of the state
- LB 98 (*Friesen*) Extend certain levy authority for natural resources districts
- LB 42 (*Hilkemann*) Change occupant protection system provisions for children and adopt certain federal safety provisions
