The following rules apply to Consent Calendar:

- 1) If any three members of the Legislature object to the bill being considered on Consent Calendar, please advise the Clerk in writing. Such requests must be filed with the Clerk prior to the expiration of 15 minutes of debate, at this stage of consideration, on the bill to be removed.
- 2) Upon either the completion of debate or the expiration of 15 minutes, whichever comes first, a vote shall be taken to advance the bill and on any pending motions or amendments pursuant to Rule 5, Section 6(d).
- 3) Any amendment adopted, other than the standing committee amendment, which adds new subject matter to the bill will result in the bill not being scheduled at the next stage of debate.

- LB 889 (*Wayne*) Provide and eliminate duties relating to fire codes
- LB 766 (*Brasch*) Change provisions relating to division fences
- LB 717 (*Howard*) Change training requirements under the Quality Child Care Act
- LB 859 (*Hansen*) Change records relating to employee deaths which may be withheld from the public
- LB 1000 (*Briese*) Require a bond election under the Public Facilities Construction and Finance Act
- LB 1003 (*McDonnell*) Change leave of absence without loss of pay provisions under the Military Code
- LB 983 (*Ebke*) Change provisions relating to audiovisual court appearances
- LB 982 (*Morfeld*) Provide for persons eighteen years of age or older to consent to certain behavioral health services
- LB 1036 (*Kolowski*) Change the expenditure limit for a recognition dinner under the Local Government Miscellaneous Expenditure Act
- LB 1038 (*Thibodeau*) Provide a deadline for electronic voter registration
- LB 682 (*Blood*) Provide consumer protection and civil relief for servicemembers and provide a duty for the National Guard
- LB 749 (*Williams*) Change provisions relating to recording and filing fees
- LB 786 (*Vargas*) Change terminology related to county government
- LB 1030 (*Friesen*) Change the sales tax sourcing rules for certain motor vehicles and trailers
- LB 1052 (*Pansing Brooks*) Require instruction and teacher education related to dyslexia
- LB 1110 (*Vargas*) Require annual reporting of school performance scores and classifications
