The following rules apply to Consent Calendar:

- 1) If any three members of the Legislature object to the bill being considered on Consent Calendar, please advise the Clerk in writing. Such requests must be filed with the Clerk prior to the expiration of 15 minutes of debate, at this stage of consideration, on the bill to be removed.
- 2) Upon either the completion of debate or the expiration of 15 minutes, whichever comes first, a vote shall be taken to advance the bill and on any pending motions or amendments pursuant to Rule 5, Section 6(d).
- 3) Any amendment adopted, other than the standing committee amendment, which adds new subject matter to the bill will result in the bill not being scheduled at the next stage of debate.

LB 848 (*Ebke*) Correct a provision relating to possession of a deadly weapon by a prohibited person

LB 847 (*Ebke*) Change provisions relating to waiver of certain testamentary rights of surviving spouses

LB 732 (*Riepe*) Change reporting dates for the Nebraska Children's Commission and committees appointed by the commission

LB 840 (*Riepe*) Change reporting requirements for the Foster Care Review Office

LB 708 (*Bolz*) Change provisions relating to juvenile court bridge orders

LB 885 (*Harr*) Change provisions relating to property tax protests

LB 1012 (*Harr*) Authorize self-service storage facility operator insurance producer licenses

LB 701 (*Kolterman*) Provide for telehealth practice by physicians and physician assistants

LB 742 (*Lindstrom*) Change provisions relating to noncompete agreements under the Franchise Practices Act
