## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1098 changes dollar thresholds for which purchase bidding process is required under the County Purchasing Act for purchases of personal property or services.

Currently, a sealed bidding process is required if the estimated value is \$20,000 or more. Under the bill, this would increase to \$50,000.

A process of securing and recording at least 3 informal bids is required if the estimated value is between \$5,000 and \$20,000. The bill would increase this to between \$10,000 and \$50,000.

An open market purchase is required if the estimated value is less than \$5,000. The bill would increase this to \$10,000.
