Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 11 would clarify that an order refusing to transfer a case from the jurisdiction of the county or district court to the jurisdiction of the juvenile court, or an order transferring a case from the jurisdiction of the juvenile court to the jurisdiction of the county or district court, is a final order for purposes of appeal. LB 11 would also establish that in the event a case is transferred from the jurisdiction of the juvenile court to the jurisdiction of the county or district court, the juvenile court may continue to enter temporary orders in the best interest of the juvenile during the pendency of appeal.
