Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB149 is a shell bill which was introduced this year as part of the Appropriation Committee's contingency plan for the ongoing budget situation in Nebraska. As the Committee advances its budget recommendation, there may be additional deficits or changes to existing deficits as enacted earlier this session under LB22. These potential changes would become part of the Committee's budget recommendation.
