Summary of purpose and/or changes:

In certain counties the county surveyor performs all the duties and possess all the powers and functions of the county highway superintendent.

LB 200 makes this applicable to counties with less than 150,000 inhabitants, but more than 75,000 inhabitants.

It was previously applicable to counties with less than 150,000 inhabitants, but more than 50,000 inhabitants.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 21 uses a 60,000 population threshold rather than the 75,000 in the original bill, and also applies it to the statutes that govern when the county surveyor is the ex officio county engineer.
