## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 304 would amend the Nebraska Housing Agency Act to make a number of changes, including:

- Eliminating certain residency requirements for county housing agencies
- Changing the holding period for abandoned personal property of housing agency tenants
- Modifying the time period for submission of housing agency annual reports
- Revising conflict of interest thresholds for housing agencies
- Updating language on procurement limits and planning requirements to mirror federal regulation
