Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 321 would alter statutes pertaining to the unlawful possession of a firearm at a school, most notably to the allowable exceptions contained in the statute. The bill would make a minor technical change to current exemption (d) of Neb. Rev. Stat. 28-1204.04 by changing the exemption for a "college or university rifle team", removing the specific designation "rifle" to now read "college or university team" at a school is a Class IV felony. Currently, only rifle team members are currently excluded from the general prohibition against possessing a firearm at a school
