Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 383 would allow a regular or alternate member of a planning commission for a city of the first class, city of the second class, or village to hold other municipal office, except as a member of a community redevelopment authority under the Community Development Law or as a member of a citizen advisory review committee under the Local Option Municipal Economic Development Act.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 49 clarifies that a regular or alternate member of a planning commission for a city of the first class, city of the second class, or village may not also hold the office of mayor, city council member, or village board of trustees member.
