Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 399 would amend the Nebraska Housing Agency Act to make a number of changes governing housing agencies for cities of the metropolitan class, including:

- Requiring that such housing agencies have a 7-member board
- Requiring that such board members obtain professional certification
- Requiring that such boards include commissioners with experience in various professional areas
- Prohibiting a member of the city council from also serving on the board of such housing agency

LB 399 would also permit a housing agency to advertise for the resident commissioner position prior to the actual vacancy and eliminate written notice requirements for the selection of the resident commissioner.
