Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill amends Section 20-170, which authorizes a mother to breast-feed her child in any public or private location where she is authorized to be by extending this protection to a mother attending a public, private, denominational, or parochial school and further requires the school to provide a private or appropriate facility or accommodation for milk expression and storage.
