Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 705 eliminates the six hundred credit requirements for esthetician licensure. Adds an additional option to become an esthetics instructor by having a current license as an esthetician in Nebraska and two years of experience as an esthetician immediately prior to submitting the instructor application.

SECTION BY SECTION:

Section 1: Amends Section 38-1062 of the Cosmetology, Electrology, Esthetics, Nail Technology, and Body Art Practice Act for licensure of an esthetician to eliminate the six hundred credit requirement. Adds an additional option to become an esthetics instructor by having a current license as an esthetician in Nebraska and two years of experience as an esthetician immediately prior to submitting the instructor application.

Section 2: Repeals Section 38-1062.
