**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 749 has two provisions.

First, it eliminates recording fees for biennial reports required by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 21-19,172.

Second, it prevents the Secretary of State from collecting a recording fee for a biennial report by an entity declared to be a corporation under Neb. Rev. Stat. § 21-608, which deals with fraternal and charitable organizations.
