Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 854 would amend the definition of "municipality" under the Nebraska Municipal Land Bank Act, enabling any municipality in the State of Nebraska to create a land bank. Currently, only municipalities located within a county in which a city of the metropolitan class is located (Douglas County) or within a county in which at least three cities of the first class are located (Sarpy County) are eligible to create a land bank.

LB 854 would also clarify that land banks may enter into agreements under the Interlocal Cooperation Act for the joint administration of multiple land banks.
