## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill amends Neb. Rev. Stat. 85-2002 which contains the definitions for the Community College Gap Assistance Program Act. Eligible programs are expanded to include non-credit programs of not less than 16 contract hours in length and credit programs consisting of less than 16 contract hours or 24 quarter hours offered during not less than 15 weeks of instruction.

## **Explanation of amendments:**

The amendment clarifies that the Gap funds remain the funds of last resort by not creating any overlap with federal Pell Grant eligibility by stating that a program is gap fund eligible if it is of insufficient length to be Pell Grant eligible.
