## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would place restrictions on healthcare practitioners desiring to prescribe a controlled substance listed on Schedule II of the Controlled Substances Act or any other opiate not listed in Schedule II. In order to lawfully prescribe such drug, the practitioner must first discuss certain information with the patient, or with the patient's parent or guardian if the patient is younger than eighteen years old and is not emancipated.

The healthcare practitioner would be required to discuss the following topics: risks of addiction and overdose, reasons why the practitioner deems the prescription necessary, and alternative treatments that may be available. Such discussions would be required prior to the first prescription and again prior to issuing a third prescription to the patient. The practitioner would be required to include a note in the patient's medical record confirming that the mandated discussion occurred.
