Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would require that customers show photographic identification when receiving dispensed opiates currently scheduled under Scheduled II, III, IV, or V of the Uniform Controlled Substances Act.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 1841 replaces the word "customer" in the existing bill and replaces it with "individual." The amendment also adds an exception for patients, residents, and employees of licensed healthcare facilities so long as there are related identification procedures in place at the facility.
