Explanation of Estimate:

This bill will repeal the Nebraska Graded Egg Act. The relevant provisions would become part of the Pure Food Act. This bill will update the Nebraska Pure Food Act.

The bill creates a separate fee category for delivery services. Currently they would be listed under the "All Other Food Establishments" category. The proposed fee will be the same as the one charged for mobile food units. It is indeterminable the number of future permit and inspection fees and this bill has minimal fiscal impact on the Department.
