Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill requires criminal background checks for all licensed child care providers.

Recent changes to the federal Child Care Block Grant Program mandate that all child care providers undergo a criminal background check. Failure to comply could result in the loss of all or a portion of the block grant funding. Nebraska receives over \$30 million annually.

Approximately 14,500 child care providers would need the criminal background checks. The State Patrol conducts the checks. The cost per check is \$45.25. The State Patrol would have increased revenue of approximately \$656,125 annually. Because of the need to hire 18 additional staff, purchase additional scanners and equipment, costs are expected to exceed revenue by \$1,200,301 in FY 2018 and \$409,300 in FY 2019. The General Fund would pay the costs that exceeds revenue.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 284 requires that the State Patrol undertake a search for finger-print based criminal history record information for all licensed child care program licensees, staff, and applicable household members. This includes transmittal of the fingerprints to the FBI for a national finger-print based criminal history record information check. The bill also requires that the Agency issue a report that includes the finger-print based criminal history record information concerning the provider. Health and Human Services has estimated that the number of record checks that will be required will be 14,500. The Agency estimates that it will need to hire approximately 18 additional employees to be able to process this increase in volume. It also estimates that it will need to purchase four additional Live-Scan machines for \$28,000 each and two additional AFIS ten-print work station for \$47,500 each, as well as basic IT and office equipment for these employees. Additionally, as the fingerprints are required to be transmitted to the FBI, a charge of \$10.00 per transmission will also be incurred. Currently, the State Patrol charges a fee of \$45.25 for each finger-print based criminal history record information check. Additionally, the current workspaces would not be adequate to house the personnel and machinery added, so estimated costs for expansion of office space has been included, as well as some moving expenses and increased utility costs.
