The Department of Health and Human Services is required to establish the Palliative Care Consumer and Professional Information and Education Program. Information about the program would be made available on the department's website on or before June 30, 2018.

The department indicates a minimal cost of \$2,000 each year.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 323 would establish the Palliative Care Consumer and Professional Information and Education Program and the Palliative Care and Quality of Life Advisory Council. The Department would be required to maintain a web page regarding the program, provide a place and time for the advisory council's two annual meetings, provide staff assistance as necessary for the Council, and reimburse council members for actual and necessary expenses as provided in sections 81-1174 and 81-1177. One member of the advisory council must be a Department employee familiar with hospice and palliative medicine.

The Department would maintain the required web page, meeting place, and staff assistance with existing resources. Annual costs to reimburse council members for actual and necessary expenses are estimated at \$2,000 per year.
