Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 351 pertains to the notation of “veteran” on a drivers’ license or state identification card. Currently, veterans may apply to the Department of Motor Vehicles to have the word ‘veteran’ noted on the front of the license or card. The bill continues to provide the notation of “veteran” for the majority of veterans applying for such notation. However, the bill provides for the words “Guard-Veteran” to be noted for any veteran of the National Guard and “Reserve-Veteran” for veterans who served on reserve duty. It is assumed the bill is effective on January 1, 2019.

The Department of Motor Vehicles will have a one-time increase in computer programming expenditures to change the driver license issuance system to reflect the two new designations. The department indicates that similar modifications done by the contractor for the system cost about \$38,000 of cash funds.
