Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 399 would have no fiscal impact to state agencies.

LB 399 would establish that housing authority boards in cities of the metropolitan class have 7 members; current law allows the board to range from 5 to 7 members in all communities. LB 399 would also require that any board member for a local housing agency for a city of the metropolitan class attain a commissioner’s certification from the National Association of Housing and Redevelopment Officials, or an equivalent certification. Costs to attain the certification would be paid by the housing agency. It is estimated that any additional costs to a housing agency in a city of the metropolitan class could be carried out using its existing budget resources.
