LB 784 amends the Employee Classification Act to provide that any contractor who has unpaid fines as a result of a violation of the Employee Classification Act shall be barred from contracting with the State of Nebraska or any political subdivision until such fines are paid.

The Department of Labor indicates a cost of \$500 per fiscal year for posting on the NDOL ECA website those contractors with unpaid fines. Cost would be charged against the Contractor's Registration Cash Fund. They also indicate a minimal amount of staff time necessary and can absorb that cost.

We agree with the Department of Labor's estimate of cost.

NDOL will implement a posting on the NDOL ECA website of those contractors with unpaid fines. NDOL estimates that it will take \$500 annually against the Contractor's Registration Cash Fund to develop the file and post it on a regular basis. Through the recent process improvement efforts of the Department, it is estimated that the minimal amount of staff time needed can be absorbed.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB784 proposed to bar any contractor (as defined by 48-2902), meaning an individual, partnership, limited liability company, corporation, or other business entity engaged in a delivery service or a construction contractor business (as defined by 48-2103), and includes any subcontractor performing services for a contractor) who has unpaid fines for a violation of the Employee Classification Act from contracting with the state or any political subdivision until such fines are paid.

This proposal will require DAS to confirm that a contractor, as defined, does not have any outstanding fines associated with a violation of the Employee Classification Act. As the Department of Labor posts this information on the internet, DAS will need to modify their boilerplates and procedures to include confirming a contractor does not have outstanding fines prior to contracting with such contractor. This step can be completed using current staffing and resources.

There is no fiscal impact to the Department of Administrative Services.
