Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB791, as amended by AM2708 and AM2880, states that the chief of police, sheriff, the Nebraska State Patrol, or other agency employing a law enforcement officer shall submit a personnel change in status form to the director of the Nebraska Law Enforcement Training Center within seven calendar days after the date a law enforcement officer is hired or leaves employment.

Each law enforcement agency shall maintain a record regarding the reason for a separation of service for each law enforcement officer, and such record shall be retained for five years. The bill requires law enforcement agencies to submit a report to the Crime Commission of any officer who is terminated or allowed to resign in lieu of termination for conduct that could constitute (a) incompetence, (b) neglect of duty, (c) incapacity, (d) final conviction or pleading guilty to a felony, or (e) dishonesty or other violations of the officer's code of ethics or statutory duties.

The bill makes certain changes to the collective bargaining agreement of the Nebraska State Patrol (NSP). The bill allows the Crime Commission to subpoena witnesses, documents, or other relevant materials relating to officer certification revocation from NSP.

The bill provides that a state employee may make a report of sexual harassment to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS). DAS shall investigate the report or ensure that an investigation is conducted by the agency which employs the reporting employee. DAS and the agency which employs the reporting employee shall maintain the confidentiality of the report. The agency employing the reporting employee shall not retaliate or discriminate against the reporting employee.

The changes made by this bill shall not abrogate any labor contracts that are in effect through June 30, 2019. The bill, as amended, has the emergency clause.

The Crime Commission states that the bill, as amended by AM2708 included some of the provisions of LB792, which did have a fiscal impact on the Crime Commission. However, AM2880 eliminates the fiscal impact to the Crime Commission. Therefore, there will be no fiscal impact to the Crime Commission from this bill, as amended.

The Department of Administrative Services – Employee Relations Division states that AM2708 would require a change in Employee Relations functions and workload. The agency would absorb such functions within their current operations so there would be no fiscal impact from this bill, as amended.
