LB 98 would have no fiscal impact on state agencies.

LB 98 would amend natural resource district levies authorized under Section 2-3225 and under Section 77-3442. Current law would sunset the levies in FY2017-18, LB 98 would extend the levies through FY2025-26. The impact upon natural resources districts would depend upon decisions enacted by the governing boards, and would vary by district. Districts currently levying the assessments authorized under Sections 2-3225 and 77-3442 would be allowed to continue to do so, and there would be no loss of revenue to those districts.
