- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to state government; to amend sections 82-129
 and 82-130, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section
 13-2704.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2016; to state
 intent; to create a fund; to provide for grants from the Civic and
 Community Center Financing Fund; to change provisions relating to
 the Willa Cather historical buildings; to harmonize provisions; to
 repeal the original sections; and to declare an emergency.
- 8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

LB379 2018

- 1 Section 1. The Legislature finds and declares that:
- 2 (1) Willa Cather is a significant historical and literary figure of
- 3 <u>Nebraska;</u>
- 4 (2) There exist many Cather-related properties in Webster County
- 5 <u>that provide irreplaceable historical value to the ongoing interpretation</u>
- 6 of the significance of Cather;
- 7 (3) These properties also spur economic activity by means of
- 8 <u>national and international tourism and annual literary conferences; and</u>
- 9 (4) It is the intent of the Legislature to preserve these properties
- 10 <u>for future generations.</u>
- 11 Sec. 2. <u>The Willa Cather Historical Building Cash Fund is created.</u>
- 12 The fund shall be administered by the Nebraska State Historical Society.
- 13 The fund shall consist of any funds appropriated by the Legislature and
- 14 money donated as gifts, bequests, or other contributions from public or
- 15 private entities. The fund shall be used to preserve and restore the real
- 16 property described in section 82-130. Any money in the fund available for
- 17 investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to
- 18 the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds
- 19 <u>Investment Act.</u>
- 20 Sec. 3. Section 13-2704.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 21 2016, is amended to read:
- 22 13-2704.01 (1) The department shall use the fund to provide grants
- 23 of assistance for the following purposes:
- 24 (a) To assist in the construction of new civic centers and
- 25 recreation centers or the renovation or expansion of existing civic
- 26 centers and recreation centers;
- 27 (b) To assist in the conversion, rehabilitation, or reuse of
- 28 historic buildings; or
- 29 <u>(c) To assist in the preservation and restoration of historic</u>
- 30 buildings owned by a nonprofit organization if a contractual relationship
- 31 is created between a municipality and the nonprofit organization; or

- 1 (d) (c) To upgrade community centers, including the demolition of
- 2 substandard and abandoned buildings.
- 3 (2) Applications for grants of assistance pursuant to this section
- 4 shall be evaluated by the department pursuant to section 13-2707.
- 5 Sec. 4. Section 82-129, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 6 amended to read:
- 7 82-129 <u>(1) In 1978, the</u> The Nebraska State Historical Society
- 8 acquired may acquire, without cost to the state, clear title in the name
- 9 of the State of Nebraska to all the real and personal property as
- 10 <u>described in section 82-130</u> of the Willa Cather Pioneer Memorial and
- 11 Educational Foundation, <u>now known as the Willa Cather Foundation</u>, except
- 12 the foundation's trust account and investments which <u>are</u> shall be
- 13 retained by the foundation. The Nebraska State Historical Society may
- 14 enter into agreements with the foundation Willa Cather Pioneer Memorial
- 15 and Educational Foundation for the operation of the Willa Cather Center
- and for the real property owned by the State of Nebraska, but the society
- 17 shall be responsible for the general administration and continued
- 18 maintenance of such property and may accept gifts, grants, and bequests
- 19 for such purposes.
- 20 <u>(2) The Nebraska State Historical Society may enter into an</u>
- 21 agreement with the Willa Cather Foundation to transfer clear title of any
- 22 properties described in section 82-130 from the State of Nebraska to the
- 23 Willa Cather Foundation at no cost to either the society or foundation
- 24 other than any property transfer transactional costs to be shared equally
- 25 by the parties.
- 26 (3) In order to carry out any agreements made according to
- 27 subsection (2) of this section, the Nebraska State Historical Society may
- 28 <u>dispose of these real properties using the vacant building and excess</u>
- 29 <u>land process under sections 72-811 to 72-818.</u>
- 30 Sec. 5. Section 82-130, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 31 amended to read:

- 1 82-130 The real property of the Willa Cather Pioneer Memorial and
- 2 Educational Foundation authorized to be acquired pursuant to section
- 3 82-129 is more particularly described as follows:
- 4 (1) The Cather House described as lots 1, 2, and 3, block 24,
- 5 original town of Red Cloud, Webster County, Nebraska;
- 6 (2) The Garber Bank described as lot 21, block 31, original town of
- 7 Red Cloud, Webster County, Nebraska;
- 8 (3) The Grace Episcopal Church described as lots 19, 20, 21, 22, 23,
- 9 and 24, block 6, original town, now the city of Red Cloud, Webster
- 10 County, Nebraska;
- 11 (4) The St. Juliana Catholic Church described as lots 17, 18, 19,
- 12 20, 21, and 22, block 3, Railroad addition to the city of Red Cloud,
- 13 Webster County, Nebraska;
- 14 (5) The Burlington Depot described as lots 10, 11, 12, and 13, block
- 15 19, Railroad addition to the city of Red Cloud, Webster County, Nebraska;
- 16 and
- 17 (6) The Antonia Farmhouse described as follows: Commencing at the
- 18 northeast corner of the southeast quarter of section 27, township 4
- 19 north, range 11 west of the sixth principal meridian, Webster County,
- 20 Nebraska, thence south 895 feet; thence west 155 feet to the point of
- 21 beginning; thence west a distance of 90 feet; thence south at a right
- 22 angle a distance of 137 feet; thence east at a right angle a distance of
- 23 90 feet; thence north a distance of 137 feet to the point of beginning.
- 24 Sec. 6. Original sections 82-129 and 82-130, Reissue Revised
- 25 Statutes of Nebraska, and section 13-2704.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 26 Supplement, 2016, are repealed.
- 27 Sec. 7. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 28 passed and approved according to law.
