1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to cemeteries; to amend section 12-401,
2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change a provision relating
3 to who may be appointed to certain cemetery boards; and to repeal
4 the original section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 12-401, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
2 amended to read:

3 12-401 The mayor of any city having fewer than twenty-five thousand
4 inhabitants, by and with the consent of the council or a majority
5 thereof, and the chairperson of the board of trustees of any village, by
6 and with the consent of the village board or a majority thereof, may
7 appoint a board of not fewer than three nor more than six members, to be
8 known as the cemetery board, from among the citizens at large of such
9 city, or from among the citizens at large from the county or counties in
10 which the village is located for such village, who shall serve without
11 pay and shall have entire control and management of any cemetery
12 belonging to such city or village. Neither the mayor nor any member of
13 the council nor the chairperson nor any member of the village board of
14 trustees may be a member of the cemetery board. At the time of
15 establishing such cemetery board, approximately one-third of the members
16 shall be appointed for a term of one year, one-third for a term of two
17 years, and one-third for a term of three years, and thereafter members
18 shall be appointed for terms of three years. Vacancies in the membership
19 of the board other than through the expiration of a term shall be filled
20 for the unexpired portion of the term.

21 Sec. 2. Original section 12-401, Reissue Revised Statutes of
22 Nebraska, is repealed.
