- 20 authorized and directed to draw his or her warrants upon the funds in the
- 21 state treasury enumerated in this act, in favor of the several
- 22 <u>beneficiaries named in this act for the amount set opposite their</u>
- 23 respective names, upon the presentation of proper vouchers therefor. The
- 24 <u>several amounts appropriated in this act shall be in full payment of any</u>
- 25 and all claims, rights, causes of action, damages, and demands of every
- 26 character and kind owing by or against the State of Nebraska, its
- 27 officers, agents, and employees, and their successors and assigns with
- 28 respect to each of the beneficiaries respectively in whose favor the
- 29 appropriations are made. The director shall not deliver any warrant for
- 30 any items appropriated in this act until a receipt and release in full,
- 31 <u>releasing the State of Nebraska, its officers, employees, and agents, and</u>

1 their successors and assigns, has been filed by each of the beneficiaries

- 2 respectively. Upon presentation of the warrants, the State Treasurer is
- 3 hereby directed to pay the same out of money in the General Fund or out
- 4 of money in other funds indicated in this act not otherwise appropriated.
