**LEGISLATIVE BILL 1011**

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road; to amend
- 2 section 60-601, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2016; to
- 3 provide a duty for drivers approaching certain stopped vehicles on
- 4 any roadway as prescribed; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal
- 5 the original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-601, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,  
2 2016, is amended to read:

3 60-601 Sections 60-601 to 60-6,383 and section 2 of this act shall  
4 be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Rules of the Road.

5 Sec. 2. A driver in a vehicle on any roadway other than a  
6 controlled-access highway who is approaching a vehicle operated by a  
7 towing or vehicle recovery service, a publicly or privately owned utility  
8 maintenance vehicle, a highway maintenance vehicle, or a vehicle operated  
9 by a solid waste or recycling collection service which is stopped and  
10 displaying flashing red, yellow, or amber lights shall, unless otherwise  
11 directed by a law enforcement officer, proceed with due care and caution  
12 and:

13 (1) Move into another lane that is at least one moving lane apart  
14 from the stopped vehicle if possible under existing traffic and safety  
15 conditions; or

16 (2) If such a lane change is impossible, unsafe, or prohibited by  
17 law, reduce speed to a reasonable speed below the posted speed limit and  
18 be prepared to stop.

20 Supplement, 2016, is repealed.
