- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to public lettings and contracts; to amend
- 2 section 73-101.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change a
- 3 preference in awarding public contracts and eliminate reciprocal
- 4 preference provisions; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 73-101.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 73-101.01 When a public contract is to be awarded to the lowest
- 4 responsible bidder, preference shall be given to purchasing Nebraska
- 5 products and goods and services from a resident bidder over a nonresident
- 6 bidder if the bid submitted by the resident bidder is comparable in price
- 7 to a bid submitted by a nonresident bidder and otherwise meets the
- 8 required specifications a resident bidder shall be allowed a preference
- 9 over a nonresident bidder from a state which gives or requires a
- 10 preference to bidders from that state. The preference shall be equal to
- 11 the preference given or required by the state of the nonresident bidder.
- 12 Resident bidder as used in sections 73-101.01 and 73-101.02 means shall
- 13 mean any person, partnership, foreign or domestic limited liability
- 14 company, association, or foreign or domestic corporation, or other
- 15 <u>business entity</u> authorized to engage in business in the State of Nebraska
- 16 and whose principal place of business is in this state, including a
- 17 <u>contractor whose ultimate parent company or majority owner has their</u>
- 18 principal place of business in this state which has met the residency
- 19 requirement of the state of the nonresident bidder necessary for
- 20 receiving the benefit of that state's preference law on the date when any
- 21 bid for a public contract is first advertised or announced or has had a
- 22 bona fide establishment for doing business within this state for the
- 23 length of time established by the state of the nonresident bidder
- 24 necessary for receiving the benefit of that state's preference law on the
- 25 date when any bid for a public contract is first advertised or announced.
- 26 Any contract entered into without compliance with sections 73-101.01 and
- 27 73-101.02 shall be null and void.
- 28 Sec. 2. Original section 73-101.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of
- 29 Nebraska, is repealed.
