1 Section 1. Sections 1 to 4 of this act shall be known and may be

- 2 cited as the Legislative Ethics Act.
- 3 Sec. 2. The Legislative Ethics Board is created. The board shall
- 4 consist of members of the Legislature as follows:
- 5 (1) A chairperson elected by the members of the Legislature; and
- 6 (2) Six additional board members appointed by the Committee on
- 7 Committees of the Legislature with two such board members residing in
- 8 <u>each of the three congressional districts.</u>
- 9 Sec. 3. The Legislative Ethics Board shall:
- 10 (1) Receive and investigate complaints against any member or
- 11 <u>employee of the Legislature;</u>
- 12 <u>(2) Establish procedures for:</u>
- 13 (a) Investigating a complaint against any member or employee of the
- 14 <u>Legislature</u>;
- 15 (b) Determining and establishing what constitutes inappropriate
- 16 conduct by any member or employee of the Legislature;
- 17 (c) Determining what, if any, disciplinary sanction is appropriate
- 18 if any member or employee of the Legislature is found to have committed
- 19 <u>an act of inappropriate conduct; and</u>
- 20 <u>(d) Administering disciplinary sanctions established pursuant to</u>
- 21 this section; and
- 22 (3) Establish potential disciplinary sanctions from the Legislature
- 23 for inappropriate conduct, as determined by the committee, by any member
- 24 <u>or employee of the Legislature.</u>
- 25 Sec. 4. Submission of a complaint to the Legislative Ethics Board
- 26 <u>shall</u> not hinder the filing of a complaint with any court of law or any
- 27 <u>other appropriate agency.</u>
