- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Telecommunications Regulation

  Act; to amend sections 86-101 and 86-103, Reissue Revised Statutes

  of Nebraska; to define a term; to provide duties for certain

  telecommunications companies and the Public Service Commission; to

  provide for creation and maintenance of a statewide geographic

  information system map as prescribed; to harmonize provisions; and

  to repeal the original sections.
- 8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 4 shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Telecommunications

- 6 Sec. 2. Section 86-103, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 7 amended to read:
- 8 86-103 For purposes of the Nebraska Telecommunications Regulation
- 9 Act, unless the context otherwise requires, the definitions found in
- 10 sections 86-103.01 to 86-121 and section 3 of this act apply.
- 11 Sec. 3. <u>Geographic information system shapefiles means a digital</u>
- 12 <u>storage format containing geospatial or location-based data that can be</u>
- 13 viewed, edited, and mapped in geographic information system software.
- 14 Sec. 4. (1) Every telecommunications company providing advanced
- 15 <u>telecommunications</u> capability service in Nebraska shall file with the
- 16 commission or its designated entity on a semiannual basis:
- 17 (a) Geographic information system shapefiles of the territory in
- 18 which the telecommunications company offers advanced telecommunications
- 19 capability service with street address or land parcel level of detail;
- 20 <u>and</u>
- 21 (b) The connection speed and type of technology for each serviceable
- 22 street address or land parcel in which the telecommunications company
- 23 offers advanced telecommunications capability service.
- 24 (2) The geographic information system shapefiles shall be used to
- 25 create a statewide geographic information system map that clearly conveys
- 26 <u>the following information:</u>
- 27 <u>(a) The availability and type of advanced telecommunications</u>
- 28 capability service;
- 29 <u>(b) The areas not served by any telecommunications company providing</u>
- 30 <u>advanced telecommunications capability service;</u>
- 31 (c) The areas served by a single telecommunications company

- 1 providing advanced telecommunications capability service;
- 2 <u>(d) The household density of areas not served by a</u>
- 3 <u>telecommunications</u> company providing advanced telecommunications
- 4 <u>capability service;</u>
- 5 <u>(e) The location of towers used to transmit and receive advanced</u>
- 6 telecommunications capability service signals;
- 7 (f) The actual advanced telecommunications capability service speeds
- 8 with census block level of detail; and
- 9 (g) The types of technology used to provide advanced
- 10 telecommunications capability service.
- 11 (3) The commission shall create and maintain the statewide
- 12 geographic information system map by:
- 13 <u>(a) Contracting for and purchasing geographic information system</u>
- 14 <u>services from a third party; or</u>
- 15 (b) Working directly with telecommunications companies providing
- 16 advanced telecommunications capability service to input and process data.
- 17 <u>(4) The commission shall make geographic information system</u>
- 18 processing services available, either directly or through a contract with
- 19 <u>a third party, at no charge to any telecommunications company providing</u>
- 20 <u>advanced telecommunications capability service that requires assistance</u>
- 21 with preparing geographic information system shapefiles to fulfill the
- 22 requirements under subsection (1) of this section. The commission may
- 23 adopt and promulgate rules and regulations which shall include the
- 24 attributes of the geographic information system shapefiles and the time
- 25 and method for filing such shapefiles under this section.
- 26 (5) Data provided to the commission pursuant to this section shall
- 27 be treated as records which may be withheld from the public upon request
- 28 of the party submitting such records if the information qualifies under
- 29 <u>subdivision (3) of section 84-712.05.</u>
- 30 (6) The commission may revoke or suspend the certificate of
- 31 convenience and necessity as a telecommunications common carrier or the

1 permit as a telecommunications contract carrier of any telecommunications

- 2 <u>company which violates this section.</u>
