- 4 shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Political Accountability
- 5 and Disclosure Act.
- 6 Sec. 2. (1) No state employee shall hold office in a political club
- 7 or party.
- 8 (2) No state employee shall, while on state time, in his or her
- 9 official capacity, or using government resources of any kind:
- 10 (a) Campaign for or against a candidate;
- 11 (b) Make a campaign speech;
- 12 (c) Collect campaign contributions;
- (d) Sell tickets to a political fundraising function;
- 14 (e) Develop or distribute campaign materials or communications;
- (f) Organize or manage a political rally or meeting;
- 16 (g) Circulate petitions for a candidate or a ballot initiative;
- 17 (h) Work to register voters for one party only;
- 18 (i) Use any digital medium to communicate about party politics, a
- 19 candidate for office, or a ballot initiative unless required in the
- 20 performance of his or her official duties; or
- 21 <u>(j) Wear political buttons.</u>
- 22 (3) If the commission receives a report of a violation of this
- 23 section, the commission shall forward the report to the Attorney General
- 24 <u>for investigation</u>.
- 25 (4) If the Attorney General receives a report of a violation of this
- 26 section, the Attorney General shall investigate and prosecute as the
- 27 <u>situation warrants.</u>
- 28 (5) A violation of subsection (1) or (2) of this section is a Class
- 29 <u>I misdemeanor. A public employee convicted of such a violation shall be</u>
- 30 <u>removed from such employment.</u>
