1 Section 1. Section 49-1401, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, is 2 amended to read: 3 49-1401 Sections 49-1401 to 49-14,142 and section 2 of this act 4 shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Political Accountability 5 and Disclosure Act. Sec. 2. Any tax-exempt organization described in section 501(c)(3) 6 7 or 501(c)(4) of the Internal Revenue Code as defined in section 49-801.01 from which any income required to be reported under section 49-1496 was 8 received by the Governor, the Lieutenant Governor, the Secretary of 9 State, the Auditor of Public Accounts, the State Treasurer, the Attorney 10 General, a member of the State Board of Education, a member of the Board 11 of Regents of the University of Nebraska with the exception of student 12 13 members, a member of the Public Service Commission, or a member of the Legislature shall file a report with the Nebraska Accountability and 14 Disclosure Commission disclosing all sources of organization revenue. The 15 16 report shall be on a form prescribed by the commission and shall be filed 17 no later than ten days after the form is received from the commission with notification that the commission has identified such organization to 18 be subject to this section. 19
