- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to electricity; to adopt the Wind, Solar, and
- 2 Fuel Cell Business Financing Act.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Sections 1 to 3 of this act shall be known and may be

- 2 <u>cited as the Wind, Solar, and Fuel Cell Business Financing Act.</u>
- 3 Sec. 2. The Legislature finds that:
- 4 (1) There is a great deal of public interest in growing solar energy
- 5 <u>development in Nebraska;</u>
- 6 (2) Solar energy can provide numerous benefits, including:
- 7 (a) Reducing reliance on fossil fuels;
- 8 (b) Locking in generation costs for years to come;
- 9 (c) Providing energy at times of peak demand;
- 10 (d) Helping homeowners and businesses reduce their energy bills; and
- 11 (e) Keeping utility dollars in the community;
- 12 (3) Regulatory provisions that are confusing or burdensome can deter
- 13 <u>solar development;</u>
- 14 (4) Simplification and standardization of application procedures can
- 15 stimulate solar development; and
- 16 (5) An online application process can save time and human resources
- 17 <u>and therefore save taxpayer dollars, all while driving new revenue into</u>
- 18 <u>Nebraska.</u>
- 19 Sec. 3. <u>(1) The State Energy Office shall create a standard and</u>
- 20 <u>simple online version of Form 20, Wind, Solar, and Fuel Cell Application</u>
- 21 that can be completed and submitted electronically by an applicant.
- 22 (2) The State Energy Office shall also create easily accessible
- 23 online templates, to be used as models for wind, solar, and fuel cell
- 24 customers and development businesses, so that such customers and
- 25 businesses can clearly understand the information required by Form 20.
