- 1 Section 1. Section 20-170, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 20-170 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a mother may
- 4 breast-feed her child in any public or private location where the mother
- 5 is otherwise authorized to be, including, but not limited to, a mother
- 6 who is attending a public, private, denominational, or parochial day
- 7 school which meets the requirements for legal operation prescribed in
- 8 Chapter 79. For a mother who is attending a public, private,
- 9 denominational, or parochial day school which meets the requirement for
- 10 legal operation prescribed in Chapter 79, the school shall also provide
- 11 <u>for private or appropriate facilities or accommodation for milk</u>
- 12 <u>expression and storage</u>.
