- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to postsecondary educational institutions; to
- 2 amend sections 85-505, 85-505.01, 85-506, and 85-508, Reissue
- 3 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for tuition waiver for
- 4 National Guard members as prescribed; to eliminate provisions
- 5 relating to tuition credits; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal
- 6 the original sections.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 85-505, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 2 amended to read:

3 85-505 Any member of the Nebraska National Guard who enrolls in any 4 state-supported university, college, or community college or 5 independent, not-for-profit, regionally accredited college or university in this state shall be entitled to a waiver credit of seventy-five 6 7 percent of the resident tuition charges of such school, except that any member who attends an independent, not-for-profit, regionally accredited 8 9 college or university in this state shall receive a waiver credit in an amount no higher than that person would receive if he or she attended the 10 University of Nebraska-Lincoln. Such entitlement shall be for a period of 11 ten years from the date of the member's initial membership so long as the 12 member maintains satisfactory performance with the guard and pursues his 13 or her course of study in such institution in a manner which satisfies 14 the normal requirements of the institution. If a member is unable to 15 16 complete his or her course of study within the ten-year period due to deployment on federal or state active-duty status for not less than one 17 hundred twenty days, the Adjutant General may extend the entitlement 18 19 period for such member for a period equal to the period of such person's active-duty status, not to exceed a maximum of five years. During the 20 extended entitlement period, the member shall be subject to all remaining 21 conditions and limitations of the tuition waiver assistance program 22 23 prescribed in sections 85-505 to 85-508. The number of individuals 24 granted a tuition waiver credit shall not exceed the number specified in section 85-505.01 during any fiscal year, and the amount of tuition 25 waivers credits granted shall not exceed nine hundred thousand dollars 26 during any fiscal year. When determining to whom such tuition waiver 27 28 credit shall be awarded, priority shall be given to those individuals who have previously received tuition credits or waivers while a National 29 Guard member, and the Nebraska National Guard shall apply those program 30 qualifications and limitations consistent with efficient and effective 31

- 2 Sec. 2. Section 85-505.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 3 amended to read:
- 4 85-505.01 (1) The tuition <u>waiver</u> assistance program prescribed in
- 5 sections 85-505 to 85-508 shall not be available to:
- 6 (a) More than one thousand two hundred members during any fiscal
- 7 year;
- 8 (b) Any member who has a baccalaureate degree; and
- 9 (c) Any member who has not exhausted federal tuition assistance
- 10 benefits available to him or her.
- 11 (2) The tuition <u>waiver</u> assistance program prescribed in sections
- 12 85-505 to 85-508 shall be available to members of the Nebraska National
- 13 Guard for a period of ten years, as provided in section 85-505, from the
- 14 date of initial membership.
- 15 (3) Any member of the Nebraska National Guard receiving <u>a</u>tuition
- 16 waiver assistance under sections 85-505 to 85-508 may obtain only one
- 17 baccalaureate degree under such tuition assistance program. Only credit-
- 18 bearing courses which meet degree requirements shall be approved for \underline{a}
- 19 tuition <u>waiver</u> assistance. Members shall not receive <u>a</u>tuition <u>waiver</u>
- 20 assistance for any noncredit courses.
- 21 (4) If a member of the Nebraska National Guard voluntarily withdraws
- 22 from a course for which his or her tuition was waived pursuant to
- 23 sections 85-505 to 85-508 he or she is receiving tuition assistance, the
- 24 member shall be liable for all costs relating to such withdrawal,
- 25 including, but not limited to, all of the costs billed by the educational
- 26 institution to the Nebraska National Guard. Reimbursement shall be in
- 27 accordance with section 72-1601.
- 28 (5) Any member of the Nebraska National Guard who receives <u>a</u>tuition
- 29 <u>waiver</u> assistance shall agree in writing to serve in the Nebraska
- 30 National Guard for three years after the completion of the courses for
- 31 which tuition assistance was waived given. Any member who receives a

- 1 tuition <u>waiver</u> assistance may be asked to reimburse the State of Nebraska
- 2 if any such member leaves the Nebraska National Guard during such three-
- 3 year period. Reimbursement shall be in accordance with section 72-1601.
- 4 (6) The Military Department shall retain the responsibility and
- 5 authority to establish any limitations and controls it deems necessary to
- 6 ensure maximum fiscal efficiency and productivity of the tuition waiver
- 7 assistance program prescribed in sections 85-505 to 85-508.

- 10 85-506 An application for a tuition waiver by an It shall be the
- 11 responsibility of the individual member of the Nebraska National Guard
- 12 <u>shall include</u> to obtain a certificate from the applicant's his or her
- 13 commanding officer attesting as to his or her satisfactory guard
- 14 performance and to present the same to the educational institution in
- 15 order to obtain <u>a</u> tuition <u>waiver</u> credit. Such certification shall be
- 16 accomplished at the time of enrollment for each semester or academic term
- 17 for which a tuition waiver credit is requested. Such certification shall
- 18 include a signed agreement by the individual to serve in the National
- 19 Guard for a minimum of three years from the date of certification.
- 20 Sec. 4. Section 85-508, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 21 amended to read:
- 22 85-508 Upon receipt of an application for a tuition waiver and a
- 23 certificate described in section 85-506, the educational institution
- 24 shall waive the applicant's tuition in the amount provided in section
- 25 85-505 endorse on the certificate the dollar amount of the tuition credit
- 26 granted pursuant to such section and return such certificate to the
- 27 Nebraska National Guard office issuing the certificate. The educational
- 28 institution shall compile a record of the total dollar amount of the
- 29 tuition credits granted for the academic term. At the completion of the
- 30 academic term, the institution shall submit the total amount of such
- 31 credits together with a request for reimbursement of such amount to the
