- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road; to amend
- 2 section 60-6,356, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2016; to
- 3 change provisions relating to the operation of all-terrain vehicles
- 4 and utility-type vehicles; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 60-6,356, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 2 2016, is amended to read:
- 3 60-6,356 (1) An all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type vehicle shall
- 4 not be operated on any controlled-access highway with more than two
- 5 marked traffic lanes. The crossing of any controlled-access highway with
- 6 more than two marked traffic lanes shall not be permitted except as
- 7 provided in subsection (9) of this section. Subsections (2), (3), and (5)
- 8 through (8) of this section authorize and apply to operation of an all-
- 9 terrain vehicle or a utility-type vehicle only on a highway other than a
- 10 controlled-access highway with more than two marked traffic lanes.
- 11 (2) An all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type vehicle may be operated
- 12 in accordance with the operating requirements of subsection (3) of this
- 13 section:
- 14 (a) Outside the corporate limits of a city, village, or
- 15 unincorporated village if incidental to the vehicle's use for
- 16 agricultural purposes;
- 17 (b) Within the corporate limits of a city or village if authorized
- 18 by the city or village by ordinance adopted in accordance with this
- 19 section; or
- 20 (c) Within an unincorporated village if authorized by the county
- 21 board of the county in which the unincorporated village is located by
- 22 resolution in accordance with this section.
- 23 (3) An all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type vehicle may be operated
- 24 as authorized in subsection (2) of this section when such operation
- 25 occurs only between the hours of sunrise and sunset. Any person operating
- 26 an all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type vehicle as authorized in
- 27 subsection (2) of this section shall have a valid Class O operator's
- 28 license or a farm permit as provided in section 60-4,126, shall have
- 29 liability insurance coverage for the all-terrain vehicle or a utility-
- 30 type vehicle while operating the all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type
- 31 vehicle on a highway, and shall not operate such vehicle at a speed in

- 1 excess of thirty miles per hour. The person operating the all-terrain
- 2 vehicle or a utility-type vehicle shall provide proof of such insurance
- 3 coverage to any peace officer requesting such proof within five days of
- 4 such a request. When operating an all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type
- 5 vehicle as authorized in subsection (2) of this section, the headlight
- 6 and taillight of the vehicle shall be on and the vehicle shall be
- 7 equipped with a bicycle safety flag which extends not less than five feet
- 8 above ground attached to the rear of such vehicle. The bicycle safety
- 9 flag shall be triangular in shape with an area of not less than thirty
- 10 square inches and shall be day-glow in color.
- 11 (4) All-terrain vehicles and utility-type vehicles may be operated
- 12 without complying with subsection (3) of this section on highways in
- 13 parades which have been authorized by the State of Nebraska or any
- 14 department, board, commission, or political subdivision of the state.
- 15 (5) The crossing of a highway other than a controlled-access highway
- 16 with more than two marked traffic lanes shall be permitted by an all-
- 17 terrain vehicle or a utility-type vehicle without complying with
- 18 subsection (3) of this section only if:
- 19 (a) The crossing is made at an angle of approximately ninety degrees
- 20 to the direction of the highway and at a place where no obstruction
- 21 prevents a quick and safe crossing;
- 22 (b) The vehicle is brought to a complete stop before crossing the
- 23 shoulder or roadway of the highway;
- 24 (c) The operator yields the right-of-way to all oncoming traffic
- 25 that constitutes an immediate potential hazard;
- 26 (d) In crossing a divided highway, the crossing is made only at an
- 27 intersection of such highway with another highway; and
- 28 (e) Both the headlight and taillight of the vehicle are on when the
- 29 crossing is made.
- 30 (6) All-terrain vehicles and utility-type vehicles may be operated
- 31 outside the corporate limits of any municipality by electric utility

- 1 personnel within the course of their employment in accordance with the
- 2 operation requirements of subsection (3) of this section, except that the
- 3 operation of the vehicle pursuant to this subsection need not be limited
- 4 to the hours between sunrise and sunset.
- 5 (7) A city or village may adopt an ordinance authorizing the
- 6 operation of all-terrain vehicles and utility-type vehicles within the
- 7 corporate limits of the city or village if the operation is in accordance
- 8 with subsection (3) of this section. The city or village may place other
- 9 restrictions on the operation of all-terrain vehicles and utility-type
- 10 vehicles within its corporate limits.
- 11 (8) A county board may adopt a resolution authorizing the operation
- 12 of all-terrain vehicles and utility-type vehicles within any
- 13 unincorporated village within the county if the operation is in
- 14 accordance with subsection (3) of this section. The county may place
- other restrictions on the operation of all-terrain vehicles and utility-
- 16 type vehicles within the unincorporated village.
- 17 (9) The crossing of a controlled-access highway with more than two
- 18 marked traffic lanes shall be permitted by a utility-type vehicle if the
- 19 operation is in accordance with the operation requirements of subsection
- 20 (3) of this section and if the following requirements are met:
- 21 (a) The crossing is made at an intersection that:
- 22 (i) Is controlled by a traffic control signal; or
- 23 (ii) For any intersection located outside the corporate limits of a
- 24 city or village, is controlled by stop signs;
- 25 (b) The crossing at such intersection is made in compliance with the
- 26 traffic control signal or stop signs; and
- 27 (c) The crossing at such intersection is specifically authorized as
- 28 follows:
- 29 (i) If such intersection is located within the corporate limits of a
- 30 city or village, by ordinance of such city or village;
- 31 (ii) If such intersection is located within an unincorporated

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- 1 village, by resolution of the county board of the county in which such
- 2 unincorporated village is located; or
- 3 (iii) If such intersection is located outside the corporate limits
- 4 of a city or village and outside any unincorporated village, by
- 5 resolution of the county board of the county in which such intersection
- 6 is located.
